1,905 MM2H Applications Approved Since November 2021

The Edge – 17 October 2023

The Malaysia My Second Home (MM2H) programme has recorded 1,905 approved applications (88% of the total 2,164 applications) between November 2021 and September 2023. For the Premium Visa Programme, 57 applications were processed, 28 were approved, and the remaining 29 applications were recommended for approval.

IMF Sees Malaysia's Real GDP Rising 4.3% In 2024 On Higher Global Export Demand The Edge – 18 October 2023

Malaysia's real Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is expected to grow 4.3% in 2024, up from the 4.0% growth expected for 2023. This would mainly be driven by higher global export demand, particularly from the technology sector, according to the International Monetary Fund (IMF).

Government to Establish First Bandar PR1MA in Teluk Intan 🖻

The Malaysian Government will establish the first Bandar PR1MA in the Country near the construction site of the Universiti Pendidikan Sultan Idris campus, Tanjong Malim, Perak. Scheduled for groundbreaking in 2024, the 142-acre stimulus project will comprise approximately 1,700 newly designed People's Housing Project (PPR) units valued at RM100 million.

Camping Site Planning Guidelines Ready, Will Be Distributed Soon 🖻

The Camping Site Planning Guidelines prepared by the Ministry of Local Government Development are ready and will be distributed to local authorities nationwide soon. The comprehensive guidelines will be a reference for campsite operators in relation to licence applications, to ensure that recreation areas are safe for visitors.

Rethinking Redevelopment I

An urban renewal law is being proposed by the Ministry of Local Government Development to deal with about 140 old properties in Kuala Lumpur that cannot be redeveloped based on existing redevelopment requirements.

Protect House Buyers 🖻

Blacklisting developers behind abandoned housing or sick projects as well as introducing the "option to purchase" pre-sale agreements are among the proposals being studied to protect house buyers. These proposals are being studied by the Ministry of Local Government Development to strengthen the Housing Development (Control and Licensing) Act 1966 (Act 118).

Ipoh to Become Health City By 2025 🖻

Ipoh is set to become the best health City by 2025 with the rapid development of medical centres currently under construction. Set to be completed by the end of 2024, Ipoh will have an additional 1,000 beds.

Construction of ECRL Halfway Through I

Construction of the East Coast Rail Link (ECRL) project has achieved progress of 50.29% as of August 2023. The tunnel boring works for the first Genting Tunnel have reached 3.10 kilometres while the second Genting Tunnel has reached 4.29 kilometres, out of a total distance of 16.39 kilometres.

Malaysia to Ensure Win-Win Situation, with Optimal Benefits from BRI Projects
