Malaysia's Economy Expands Faster Than Expected in 4Q 2024

The Edge – 14 February 2025

Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) has announced that the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) grew 5% in the 4Q of 2024, slightly slower than the 3Q's revised 5.4% year-on-year growth. For the whole 2024, the Malaysian economy grew by 5.1%, higher than the 3.6% in 2023.

JS-SEZ Action Plan Expected to be Ready by 3Q 2025

The Government is preparing the Johor-Singapore Special Economic Zone (JS-SEZ) Action Plan, expected to be completed in the 3Q of 2025, with infrastructure development funded through development allocations, said the Economy Ministry.

Johor Drafting Masterplan for Johor-Singapore Special Economic Zone

The Johor State Government is drafting a masterplan for the Johor-Singapore Special Economic Zone (JS-SEZ) with input from key agencies like the Iskandar Regional Development Authority. The masterplan is expected to be finalised by June 2025.

Government Eyes 139 Land Parcels for Affordable Housing Under KL's 2040 PlanThe Edge – 18 February 2025

The Federal Territories Department has identified 139 land parcels totalling 1,228.95 hectares for potential redevelopment, which could be used for affordable housing under the Kuala Lumpur Structure Plan 2040 and Draft Kuala Lumpur Local Plan 2040 (DPTKL2040). To support this, the Draft DPTKL2040 introduces the Residential 4 Land Use zone, dedicated to affordable housing projects, including public housing, covering 354.47 hectares.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim has proposed using the Residensi Rakyat (PRR) Harmoni Madani Bestari Jaya programme as a model for estate-government collaboration in developing workers' housing.

Developers Must Give Back to Communities

Residential developers in Kuala Lumpur will soon be required to contribute to a housing fund to improve community infrastructure and amenities. The collected funds will be used to develop public facilities and upgrade infrastructure in the surrounding neighbourhoods.

LEGAL

Government Says Semantan Estate is Not Entitled to Recovery of Land

The Federal Territory Land Registrar and the Government informed the Court of Appeal that Semantan Estate (1952) Sdn Bhd is not entitled to reclaim the 263.272 acres of land known as the "Duta Enclave" in Kuala Lumpur but is entitled to compensation, in accordance with Section 29(1)(b) of the Government Proceedings Act 1956.

INFRASTRUCTURE

KL-Karak Highway Widening Project to Begin End-February 2025

The KL-Karak Highway widening project will start at the end of February 2025 and is expected to be completed in four years. The 45.3-kilometre (km) project involves adding one lane in each direction from the Gombak Toll Plaza to Bentong, Pahang.

Final Cost of Penang Light Rail Transit Yet to be Determined

The final cost of the Penang Light Rail Transit (LRT) project is yet to be determined as it depends on the ongoing procurement process and tender results. The RM13 billion approved by the Federal Government covers construction costs and land acquisition.

Selangor Rail Line to be Rolled Out in Phases Over 10 Years

The Selangor Rail Line will be constructed in phases over up to 10 years, with the feasibility study in its final phase. The proposed 200km alignment includes four spurlines to Westport, Klang, Putra Heights and Universiti Selangor (Unisel) Bestari Jaya.

Government Finalising Main Parameters for Proposed KL-Singapore HSR Project


