**Inflation Likely to Ease on Lower November Producer Price Index (PPI)**

The Statistics Department reported that the PPI fell by 1.8% in November 2025, extending the 0.1% decline recorded in October 2025. Chief statistician, Datuk Seri Mohd Uzir Mahidin said the decrease was mainly driven by a 9.7% drop in the agriculture, forestry and fishing sector, largely due to a 16.2% fall in the growing of perennial crops index.

**RM323.3 million to Boost Johor's Rural Development**

Johor has welcomed higher Federal funding for rural development, signalling continued commitment to enhancing infrastructure, welfare and livelihoods Statewide. State agriculture, agro-based industry and rural development committee chairman, Datuk Zahari Sarip said the State received RM323.3 million from the Rural and Regional Development Ministry for 2026, an 11% increase from 2025.

**Malaysia's Broad-Based Growth in Third Quarter (3Q) Reflects Strong Cooperation**

Malaysia recorded broad-based economic growth in the 3Q 2025, supported by strong performance across all major sectors, said Deputy Prime Minister, Datuk Seri Fadillah Yusof. He attributed the improvement to close cooperation among the Government, civil service, private sector and the wider community, which helped the country navigate economic and external challenges. He noted that Gross Domestic Product grew by 5.2% in 3Q 2025, compared with 4.4% in the previous quarter.

### [Selangor Smart Sewa to Include Emergency Units](#)

Selangor plans to strengthen its disaster preparedness by setting up dedicated emergency units in all Smart Sewa Scheme housing projects. State Housing and Culture Committee chairman, Datuk Borhan Aman Shah said a working paper is being finalised to incorporate these units into the scheme, ensuring residents affected by floods or other emergencies can access temporary shelter within their communities.

### [Keretapi Tanah Melayu Bhd \(KTMB\) to Terminate Southern Express Train Service](#)

KTMB will terminate its Southern Express (Ekspres Selatan) service on the Gemas–JB Sentral–Gemas route effective January 1, 2026, ending nine years of operations. In a statement, KTMB said the decision affects six services currently in operation. The move is part of a service realignment and operational optimisation in line with progress and infrastructure readiness under the Gemas–Johor Bahru Electrified Double-Tracking Project.

### [Infrastructure Upgrades to Drive Penang Development](#)

Upgrades to Butterworth KTM Station and Penang International Airport's air cargo terminal are expected to boost balanced development between Penang Island and Seberang Perai.
